BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF THE ORGANIZATION

In August 2012, the International Centre for Leadership Development Nigeria was founded by graduate student of International Institute for Global Leadership (IIGL) situated in Asheville, NC, U.S.A, and registered as a non-governmental, non-profit and non-political organization with registration no: **(CAC/IT/NO 54685)**.

The organization is also registered with the **Special Control Unit Against Money Laundering (SCUML)** of the Economic and Financial Crimes Commission (EFCC) with Certificate Number **RN: SC 251400267**.

The organization was established as the will of students to participate actively in Equipping and empowering youths and teenagers with the necessary soft skills, as well as to take an active role in the civil society development through trainings, seminars and workshops.

RANGE OF ACTIVITIES

Our activities are broadly divided into four key programmes:

1. Secondary School Soft Skills Training
2. Youth Capacity Building
3. Cyber Crime Prevention and Internet Safety Awareness Campaign (Shift Project)
4. Entrepreneurship and Social Enterprise Development.

OUR ACTIVITIES IN 2015

ICLDNG has been in the forefront empowering young people in Nigeria to be a new generation of change agents. Through 2015, ICLDNG has committed to leadership across high schools in Lagos State, Nigeria. ICLDNG has through partnership with several government institutions created programs that impact leadership, focus, career intelligence and citizenship.

In year 2015, ICLDNG worked with about 13 high schools in Lagos, Nigeria providing about 150+hours of training and development with tutelage from 7+ trainers reaching a total of 400+ students.

OUR FOCUS

ICLDNG focused on 6 topics during this school year. These training lessons were designed to help each young individual achieve career excellence, academic excellence, and technology know how.

The students were trained on the following;

- ✓ **Leadership Through Accountability and Responsibility**
- ✓ **Mentorship**
- ✓ **Goal Setting**
- ✓ **Entrepreneurship**
- ✓ **Space & Time management**
- ✓ **Internet Safety Awareness**

With these programs, students are charged with the responsibility of setting their goals and making better choices in their academic pursuits.

For **goal setting**, students were trained on how to make smart goals. The objectives were the following,

- Students learnt how to identify their strengths and focus on the things they are good at.
- Students learnt how to identify their weaknesses, what to avoid, what to improve, and where to get help from people who do those things better.

- Students learnt about what they need to mitigate, or plan for, to ensure their goal remains achievable.

For understanding technology, we had a partnership with the Economic and Financial Crimes Commission (EFCC), Mr Paul was the keynote speaker and he spoke extensively on the meaning of cybercrime and other cyber related vices. He explained the meaning of cyber bullying, spam, phishing, and phishing websites. The objectives were the following:

- Student learnt the importance of information technology.
- Students learnt the power of social media.
- Students were taught how to make the best use of the internet.
- To educate students on their role in the fight against cybercrime
- Exposure towards understanding the risk and consequences associated with getting involved in cybercrime activities and
- Also how they can protect themselves online.

For each event & program we planned, we ensured that students understood the meaning of Leadership, and to lead their lives and their careers. Mr Felix Iziomoh, the founder of ICLDNG echoed these thoughts to the students, and ensured that students could identify leaders in the society. The objectives include the following;

- Students learnt about the basics of leadership.
- Students learnt about taking responsibility and becoming the change they seek.
